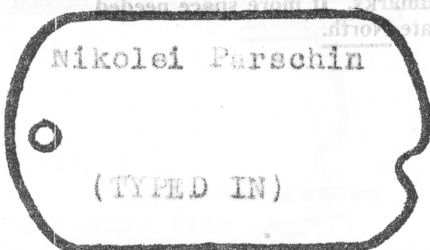

b. So much of Report of Burial for Allied deceased Paterson, Daniel 1531896, British, Plot F, Row 8, Grave 191, Margraten, as reads "Deceased's Left: Colon, Andre G. 34011, 34011 Capt. Belgian Mq, 9 Army 192" be changed to read, "Deceased's Right: Parschin, Nikolei, Russian Soldier 192.

c. So much of Report of Burial for Allied Deceased Norpalsup, Ebin (Russian) Plot F, Row 8, Grave 193, Margraten as reads: Deceased's Right Colin, Andre G., 34011, Capt, Belgian Mq, 9 Army 192, be changed to read: Deceased's Right: Parschin, Nikolei, Russian Soldier 192.
